Home Care Packages

Wongaburra provides support for older people who wish to remain living in their own home with individualised support under Level 1—4 Government Funded Home Care Packages and CHSP Funding.

Packages follow Consumer Directed Care and all packages are implemented through ongoing consultation with consumers, and/or Carers.

With CDC, consumers will get an individual budget consisting of funds the government allocates, plus the contribution made by the consumer and any income tested fees that apply. Consumers are able to spend the funds allocated by the Government on services/products that will enable them to remain living at home independently as long as possible.

To qualify for assessment for Home Care Services, you must meet some needs and age requirements. The assessment checks:

- How much assistance you need with some everyday tasks
- That you are 65 years or older (50 years or older for Aboriginal or Torres Strait Islander people).

Aged Care referral can be made through My Aged Care by:

- Yourself
- Carers or Family Member
- Service Provider
- Your GP
- Hospital

Note: If you are on a low income, homeless or at risk of being homeless, and aged 50 years or older (45 years or older for Aboriginal and Torres Strait Islander people), please call the My Aged Care contact centre on 1800 200 422 to discuss your situation.

Folks Community Program

This program offers social interaction with community members of similar age and interests. Program runs Monday and Wednesday from 9am - 2pm.

Transport to and from the program is available. In house activities and regular community outings are enjoyed by clients.

The Men's shed is open to the community Wednesday and Friday from 8am -2pm. Transport is available.
